Gogebic County Road Commission letter regarding proposed **summer road projects** and costs. A discussion regarding delaying Nylund road pulvarization, vs. blacktopping Orchard Road – considering the current cost of blacktop vs how much it will cost next summer, the fact that Orchard Road is all ready for blacktop right now was considered. Nylund Road needs extensive work to prepare for blacktop, this work could be done over the winder and next summer. Tho reluctant to do so, a motion was offered by Mr. Genisot supported by Mr. Suutala to authorize and sign the contract with the County to blacktop Orchard Road this summer at the matching cost of 50% our share is \$42,500. The motion carried on a unanimous roll call vote.

New business:

A need for an advisory committed for Parks and Recreation was discussed. In order to continue to apply for various grants, the Township should have a committee. A motion was offered by Mr. Brunello supported by Mr. Suutala to set up the advisory committee for parks and recreation, the committee will consist of those interested in serving from the township. The motion carried.
